Gist of Schwend's statements:

Herbert Yohn - this reporter for Revista Careta is a close friend and is his channel to General Lindley, but this is via an army colonel FNU Souza, who is in counterespionage activity, and who is also a friend of Schwend. Yohn has numerous contacts among leftists, although he is not one himself. The only contact of Yohn that Schwend could name was Salomon Bolo, from whom Yohn received a locally postmarked letter yesterday.

Major Alberto Taborga: - ~~Taborga~~ Taborga used a falsified passport from another country other than Bolivia because he has been a political exile from Bolivia since the revolution. He is now engaged in plotting a counter-revolution, and in this he is being aided by several large mining companies with holdings in Bolivia.

Luis Homidas Sanchez Perez - He is the secretary general of the Sindicato de Obreros de Motor Import S. A., Schwend's employer. Schwend knows he is a Communist because he has had many talks with him and has found him to be of Communist orientation.

Arms smuggling into Peru from Bolivia - Most of the weapons come through Juliaca. Schwend has a friend in that town whom he is going to ask to buy a submachinegun. Schwend said this could cause him no difficulty and he would like to have a submachinegun at home, since he lives somewhat out in the country.
