<p>a. Letter from Subject dated 22 July 1965 addressed to person identified as Federico aka Fritz Schwend which Subject claims never was sent.</p> <p>b. Letter dated 10 September 1965, received by Subject from Joseph J. Palisi in Washington, D. C.</p> <p>c. Letter received by Subject from person identified as his ex-wife (Friederike Schlapp).</p> <p>d. Copy of a letter purportedly written by a former Luftwaffe war hero named Col. Hans Ulrich Rudl to Subject's ex-wife.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(Station is unable to comment on the contents or authenticity of the letters contained in attachment C since it was never given the opportunity of viewing the originals.)</p> <p>Attachment D - A spontaneous statement dated 29 April 1966 voluntarily submitted by Subject prior to his first interrogation on 30 April.</p> <p>Attachment E - Full length identity photographs of Subject for each addressee and Headquarters for whom four copies are attached.</p> <p>2. A brief summary of Subject's allegations and sworn or spontaneous statements against Fritz Schwend follows:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Subject claims to have lived with Schwend during the period April - July 1965 at which time he became privy to many of Schwend's activities, principally by helping him with his correspondence. He alleges - that Schwend was involved with a person named Klaus Altman, presumed confidant of Gen. Rene Barrientos, in a plot to eliminate Victor Paz Estenssoro; that Altman visited Schwend's home while serving as a courier between La Paz and Lima to pick up tape recordings of conversations between Schwend and Paz Estenssoro and to pass on instructions, - that Schwend was engaged in double dealing during the period of active guerrilla warfare in Peru in 1965 by promoting a scheme whereby Schwend would provide the [] with info on the whereabouts and activities of MIA leaders on the one hand while selling arms to the latter on the other.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- That Schwend corresponds with a person named Julius MADER residing on Franzosischestrasse in E. Berlin from whom Schwend receives SMR propaganda bulletins twice monthly.- That the Miro Quesada family once offered Schwend two million dollars to murder Haya de la Torre.- That Schwend made offers to both the U.S. and Cuban Governments involving the sale of info on Peru and Bolivia (including audio coverage of Paz Estenssoro's conversations) in exchange for \$5,000 per month and that the offer to the U.S. Government was made thru Joseph J. Palisi.

<p>- That Schwend has contacts in Hong Kong, Israel and the Arab countries of the Middle East.</p> <p>- That Schwend receives protection from Javier Campos Montoya of PIP and the Miro Quesada family in return for services he renders them such as collaborating as an informant, promoting business pay-offs etc.</p> <p>- That Schwend sold false information to Werner Lange of <u>El Correo</u></p> <p>- That Schwend has access to an arms cache located in Bolivia.</p> <p>- That Schwend tried to involve Subject in covert intelligence operations against the MIR, Paz Estenssoro etc.</p> <p>3. According to his own statements, Subject co-habited in Lima with a woman named Carmen ROSA Zevallos Gomez by whom he had a son named Felipe Zevallos born 4-5 months ago.</p> <p>4. Headquarters attention is called to the discrepancy in the dates of Subject's entry into Peru from Rio de Janeiro. Attachment A substantiated by Subject's own statements gives it as 28 April 1960. Attachment B lists it in two places as 26 April 1961. <input type="checkbox"/> <input type="checkbox"/> has been asked to clarify this matter.</p> <p>5. According to the latest report received from <input type="checkbox"/> <input type="checkbox"/> French Embassy officials in Lima have been called in on this case and are currently negotiating to have Subject deported to France. To date, there is no evidence that the Peruvian authorities plan to take any action against Schwend as a result of the allegations made by Roesch.</p> <p>6. Additional information on Schwend obtained from other sources will be forwarded by pouch.</p> <p>7. For <input type="checkbox"/> <input type="checkbox"/> Suggest traces on Klaus Altman be forwarded to Headquarters.</p> <p>8. Also, it is suggested that Headquarters and Berlin run traces on Julius MADER as a check on both Schwend's possible I.S. connections and ROESCH's testimony.</p> <p>9.
