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B. Documents

- a) Soldbuch issued on 20 Sep 44 by SS Ausbildungsabteilung "KONITZ" with identity disc No. : SS Ausb. Abt. KONITZ 11991.
- b) Italian Civilian identity card No. 91405 issued at VERONA on 8 Jul 44 in the name Dr. Walter SEGNI, Salesman of Italian nationality, living at 6, Via Accademia, MILAN.
- c) Italian Reserve officers identity card No. 165978 issued at BOLZANO, 16 Jul 1936.
- d) SD identity card No. 356 issued in BERLIN on 1 Jul 1944.
- e) SD permit to wear uniform issued on 19 Jan 43 in BERLIN.

C. Circumstances of Capture

P# had withdrawn from CGO to the SD HQ at Hotel REGINA in MILAN in order to await the arrival of the Allies. He surrendered to American troops on 27 Apr 45 and arrived at CSDIC Sub-Centre 15 A.G. on 2 May 45 for interrogation.

D. Previous Activities

1. P#, after school education in STEINACH, and BOLZANO, studied law at PADUA, TURIN and INNSBRUCK Universities and from 1932 - 33 did military training with the Italian Army.
2. From 1934 until 1938 he practised as a solicitor in BOLZANO and from 1930 to 1939 in SILLAURO. In 1939 he opted for German nationality and was employed in 1940 as a civilian with the "Umsiedlungskommission" in BOLZANO.

E. GIS Career

1. In Mar 42 P# was ordered to report to 102/103 WILHELM-STRASSE, BERLIN where he had interviews with Obersturmbannfuhrer GENGEBACH, advisor in Abt IIIa, and with Obersturmbannfuhrer SEPP, head of Abt III. He was entailed in the SD Abt III, stayed a fortnight in BERLIN and was posted to the HAGUE.
2. In the HAGUE, Holland P# served under Gen HARSTER who was E d. S for HOLLAND. He worked in Abt III, supervising legal procedure and acting as a control centre for the Aussenstellen at ROTTERDAM, AMSTERDAM, ARNHEIM, GRONINGEN and MAASTRICHT.
3. As far as P# can remember the personnel at the HAGUE was as follows :

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- Head of Abt I and II : Regierungsrat Dr. DEFFNER
followed by Regierungsrat Dr. ARIT
- Head of Abt III : Obersturnfuhrer KNOLLE
- Head of Abt III B : (?) Hauptsturnfuhrer FAHRENHOLZ
- Head of Abt IV : Regierungsrat WOLFF (later
succeeded by DEFFNER)
- Head of Abt V : Hauptsturnfuhrer WENSKI
- Head of Abt VI : Hauptsturnfuhrer MUELLER

ITALY

- 4. On 3 Sep 43, Gen HARSTER was ordered to go to ITALY and PW accompanied him as interpreter/ADJ. They flew to BERLIN where Gen HARSTER had interviews with Obegruppenfuhrer HALTENBERGER and Brigadefuhrer SCHULZ. The General and PW then stopped at MUNICH on 7 Sep where the General saw General von KAMPE, Befehlshaber der Ordnungspolizei.
- 5. On 13/14 Sep Gen HARSTER and PW arrived at MERANO and the General had further conversations with Field Marshal ROHMEL and General WOLFF at GARDA. The General visited towns in NORTH ITALY and started setting up Aussonstollen of the SD in GENOVA, TURIN, and VENICE and other places. "SS", Standortfuhrer RAUFF was charged with setting up the SD centre in MILAN.
- 6. On 8 or 9 Oct the General moved to VERONA with RADLIZER and GOEBEL (IO to German Embassy). The remainder of the staff arrived later. PW "organised" the equipment of the SD HQ in VERONA and acted as civil adviser to Gen HARSTER.

SS Training Centre

- 7. From Nov 43 onwards PW was concerned with the erection of a training school at CABIANCA for Italian recruits to be trained as guards for SD premises. (AUSBILDUNGSSCHULE CABIANCA); the school was completed in Feb 45. Two hundred recruits were provided by VISCONTI (Chief of Italian port police) in Apr/May 44 and they were posted to SD offices (except for MILAN) in Jun/Jul 44. The school then became a reserve location for SD VERONA.

The CIANO Affair

- 8. In Dec 43 Count CIANO was moved by the Italian Republican Authorities to Fort CASTELVECCIO, pending his trial. Negotiations had been going on with SD BERLIN for CIANO's release provided that CIANO's representative handed over the records of the Italian foreign office for the period 1935 - mid 1940 and of his personal diary. PW was instructed by Gen HARSTER to accompany Frau PEETZ of Abt VI (BERLIN) and Emilio PUCCI (acting for Edda CIANO) to ROMA, where the records but not the diary were collected and brought to VERONA.

SECRET

9. Subject flew by plane to VIENNA and continued by road to BERLIN where he delivered six volumes of CIANO's records to KALLENBURNER at SD HQ in BERLIN on 8 or 9 Jan 44.

CIANO's DIARY

10. On the day previous to CIANO's execution, (PV states that HITLER had at the last moment voted CIANO's liberation) Edda CIANO called on HARSTER and was told by the latter that he would do what he could for her. (PV later learned that Edda CIANO was wearing the diary in a special belt round her waist.) The following day HARSTER and PV called at the convalescent home at RAMICOLA (near PARMA) where Edda CIANO was staying. The doctor told them that Edda CIANO had retired to bed with a sleeping draught.
11. HARSTER and PV returned to VERONA but were awakened at midnight by Frau DEPTZ who had been living close to the convalescent home in order to watch Edda CIANO. She arrived with the news that Edda CIANO had left with FUCCI at 1500 hrs the previous day. All SD frontier posts were warned to prevent her leaving ITALY and early next day FUCCI was arrested between MERCANO and MESCLA. He stated that he was on his way to meet Edda CIANO at SONDRIO. He was escorted there by the SD but Edda CIANO did not arrive. FUCCI was subsequently sent by RAUFF to contact Edda CIANO in SWITZERLAND but he was interned by the Swiss.

PANCINO

12. At end Jan 44, MUSSOLINI wished to reconcile himself with his daughter Edda and he called to FASANO a Franciscan priest from ERTO (Udine) known as Padre PANCINO who had known Edda as a child.
13. MUSSOLINI through his minister MEZZASOLA and the IO to the German embassy (GOEBEL) asked for PANCINO to be conveyed to ROME in order to obtain papal authorization to visit Edda in SWITZERLAND. PV conveyed PANCINO to ROME in Feb 44, where PANCINO had interviews with Archbishop COSTANTINO and Secretary of State TARDINI, who told the Nuncio in BERN (DESMARDES) to assist PANCINO on his arrival in SWITZERLAND.
14. PANCINO met with difficulties at the Swiss consulate in CGO in securing a visa for SWITZERLAND and owing to the breakdown of the phone service to ROME, PV conveyed him to ROME once more and PANCINO had further conversations with the Vatican authorities.
15. At that time Gen HARSTER asked PV to approach PANCINO with a view to securing CIANO's personal diary which Edda had taken with her to SWITZERLAND. PANCINO politely refused to negotiate but agreed to ask her not to make public its contents. On his return from SWITZERLAND PANCINO said that Edda was prepared to keep the diary secret until after the war, when she would be needing more money.
16. At end Feb 44, PV escorted PANCINO who was again going to SWITZERLAND to the Swiss frontier. PANCINO this time carried with him Lire 4,000,000 in Italian bonds belonging to MUSSOLINI which he converted through an old school fellow named COZZOLA in MILAN. PANCINO succeeded in converting the bonds into Swiss francs and £ sterling. PANCINO returned to ITALY

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at end Mar 44 and reported to MUSSOLINI at FASANO. In Apr 44 PANCIÑO once more visited Edda on behalf of MUSSOLINI, who sent her Francs 12,000 (Swiss). In Jun, Jul, Aug, PANCIÑO was confined to his village (SERTO) owing to Partisan activities in the area.

Return of FEETZ

17. In May 44 Frau FEETZ who had been to BERLIN returned to VERONA in an attempt to contact Edda CIANO in SWITZERLAND. She failed to secure permission to enter SWITZERLAND. She then made it known to PW that Edda had left one of her documents in the Nursing Home at RAVIOLA:

Recovery of Documents

18. PW, in order to overawe the doctor at the nursing home, sent two SD HQs to collect him in a car and they told him that he would have to go with them and be absent from the home for 48 hours. The car took the doctor to PARMA, where PW met him at the SD Stallo and asked him if he was willing to hand the documents of Edda CIANO over. The doctor agreed only too willingly. The documents included a war diary (1914 - 1918) of MUSSOLINI and diplomatic documents exchanged between ITALY, GERMANY, AUSTRIA, HUNGARY and the BALKANS (giving details of negotiations leading up to this war). Frau FEETZ returned with the documents to BERLIN where, PW believes, she was engaged in translating them.

The PESSINA Family

19. From these documents PW traced a connection between Edda CIANO and the PESSINA family living near COLO. In Jun/Jul 44 he called at their house accompanied by two SD HQs and interrogated the family. Mr and Mrs PESSINA denied all knowledge of any documents of Edda but the daughter promised PW that if they did have anything belonging to Edda CIANO they would not publish it.

20. PW made several trips to GENOA and TURIN to purchase petrol for the HQ at VERONA and in Aug 44, on hearing that BENO was freed from Partisans, he fetched PANCIÑO and took him to FASANO, where the priest saw MUSSOLINI. The latter gave PANCIÑO a few things for his daughter Edda in SWITZERLAND. PW paid PANCIÑO about six sums of Lire 10 - 15,000 in the ensuing months but cannot remember the dates.

Peace proposals

21. In Sep 44 PW, with the approval of WOLFF and HARSTER, began preparing peace proposals. PW's proposals were based on the following conclusions:
 - a) that Germany had lost the war and more profitable conditions would come from the Western Allies,
 - b) that Germany should therefore withdraw all but a skeleton force from the WEST and put the resultant forces into the Eastern front.HARSTER made PW alter the proposals so that the form might be acceptable to higher authority and sent them at the end of Sep 44 to SD BERLIN (Abt. VI).

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Information Sources

22. PW's sources for political and industrial information were MARINOTTI (of SEILÁ VISCOSES) DE ANGELI FRUA (SIEDAG) FESSINA (of COEIO silk industry) all of whom he describes as pro-allied.

KAMATZ

analyzed From Aug - Sep onwards PW lived at CERNORIO, with KAMATZ Fritz, in a villa belonging to "GRENZSTELLE WEST", a frontier control centre which collected information from SWITZERLAND and collated information from other frontier stations. KAMATZ, a German merchant, was employed by Abt VI for liaison with the German consul in LUGANO (von NEURATH) and for the purchase of daily newspapers in SWITZERLAND.

Activities with Abt VI

23. In Dec 44 PW started working for Abt VI. MUSSOLINI had been informed by an agent that Fascism was being re-activated in Allied occupied territory and had asked for German assistance through the ambassador RAIN *ed*. PW was ordered to liaise with the Fascist Republican party and together with HUEGEL (Abt VI) visited RAIN at FASANO. RAIN talked wildly about winning the war by sabotaging divisions in ROE and passed them on to Prof BRIZZIG at the Hotel BELLA RIVA. BRIZZIG introduced them to PAVOLINI and PUCCI, with whom PW was to work in MILAN. HUEGEL later told PW that he was not to allow the Italians any V/T facilities.
25. HARSTEN told PW before he left that he was to keep a watch on the Fascist Republican party and their affiliated organisations, though he had a poor opinion of the Italians. PW was also to look out for any rival organisation which might offer better prospects of success.
26. PW was given an office by the Fascist party in 2 via RENZI, MILAN and he liaised with PUCCI and Capt del MASCA at 12, via MOZART, MILAN.

Agents

27. PW estimates that the Fascist party sent out twenty agents between Dec 44 and Apr 45, of whom three came back. PW saw only one of the three. This agent had been sent to ROE in Dec 44 and returned at beg Mar 45 and was despatched again after a fortnight, though PW does not know what his destination was to be.
28. In mid-Feb 45 a man named "TITO" who had been sent by the Fascist party in PALERMO was interrogated at 12, via MOZART. "TITO" had taken 11 days to reach enemy occupied territory from PALERMO and had then spent six weeks in the goal at SANNA under suspicion without being interrogated.
29. At this time PW arranged for two agents (names unknown) to be sent through HASS (Einheit IDA) but owing to their behaviour HASS said he would not do it again as it imperilled his own organisation.

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30. At beg Feb, del MASSA was preparing to send 20 armed men (Gruppo ^{ed} CEPESOLA (?)) through the lines to the GRUPPO BASSO area. Of these twenty PW knows that owing to the treatment that they were receiving, 14 volunteered for labour in GERMANI and the remainder were transferred to the stay-behind force of PUCCI. (cf para 45).

31. At beg Apr del MASSA despatched an agent called WESTRDI with a brother and two sisters on a mission to PIOMBINO for the purpose of contacting the Party there. The four got as far as PIZZA where they were arrested by the QUESTURA and HASS (Einheit:) signalled P. to see that no more were sent.

Informants

32. At end Feb del MASSA introduced one of his informants BARTEZZATI ^{ed} (alias Dr PUTZER), a former SE man, to PW. BARTEZZATI provided PW with three names :

- MAKINGO (alias "TRIVESI")
- SECCI
- NANCIAGALLI

He told PW that these were British agents who were coming constantly over the Swiss border, to liaise with Partisans. PW made enquiries at frontier control posts but was not able to trace them. BARTEZZATI was not paid by PW but received Lire 20,000 from del MASSA.

BLASIC

33. While at CERNOBBIO, PW had met Capt BLASIC (a former IAF officer) who had previously lived in TRIESTE and had left there owing to lack of work at the airport due to petrol shortage. Capt BLASIC who had left the Fascist party in Jul 43 now offered to provide PW with agents to penetrate the Italian Republican Fascist party and was going to recruit them from IAF personnel. He failed to do so owing to the collapse of the German Army and the subsequent confusion. ^{ed}

Gracfin SAVORGNANI

34. On the occasion of a visit to VERONA in Jan 45, PW was introduced by HUBBEL (Abt VI) to the Gracfin SAVORGNANI (an ardent Slovene, now CECHET) who had been sent by Dr JOHANNES of GUILLEMER REIDER's staff in TRIESTE. ^{ed} HUBBEL told PW to take her with him as a useful informant and she came to live with him at CERNOBBIO.

35. PW found out that she was in touch with the Yugoslav GLJULIC, for whom PW thought she was operating, and from whom she had an identity card in the name "PETROVIC". She was also in contact with VITOLOVICH, communist member of the Comitato di Azione, TRIESTE. ^{ed}

36. SAVORGNANI started operating for PW and gave him information from a source called FUMAI who had been a (?) Comd in X Flotilla MAS and had been expelled from the unit for being pro-fascist and anti-BORGHESE. ^{ed}

37. SAVORGNIANI informed PW that Prince ~~SORRELLI~~ had held an officers meeting in Feb 45 and had told them that ~~GERMANI~~ would lose the war, that he was prepared to collaborate with the Western Allies but not with the communists. *ed*

SIC

38. She also provided PW with information on SIC (SERVIZIO INFORMAZIONI CAPO) which was an Intelligence Agency of MUSSOLINI in TRIEST for the purpose of combatting German and Partisan infiltration. The leader was Italo SAURO who liaised with PUCCI in VENICE and with MUSSOLINI at SARGIANO. Of SIC agents SAVORGNIANI knew only COMESSI Pietro. *ed*

Attempt at Negotiations

39. At beg Feb 45 PW again tried to contact the Western Allies and asked WOLFF for permission to do so. WOLFF told her that he had his own contact with the Allies but that there could never be too many irons in the fire. HARSTER also gave PW his unofficial sanction.

40. At beg Mar 45 PW fetched PANCINO (Fr. ERIO) and persuaded him to go to ~~SENO~~ to contact the Papal nuncio ~~BERGAMINI~~ with a view to enquiring whether the Vatican was willing to negotiate between the powers. Father PANCINO agreed to go. He returned a fortnight later to say that he had contacted the Vatican and that the Allies had agreed to accept peace proposals. Father PANCINO insisted on returning to his Parish for Easter and PW was unable to send him to ~~SENO~~ again.

41. At end Mar PW also tried to contact the Allies through Graefin SAVORGNIANI, after the latter had returned from a visit to TRIEST. She told PW that GIJUGO had liberated the patriarch CAVRILO from a concentration camp and that the latter was shortly leaving for ENGLAND. PW took SAVORGNIANI to SD VERONA where he secured HARSTER's permission to pay her lire 300,000 for her expenses in going to TRIEST and contacting the Allies through GIJUGO and CAVRILO.

42. After PW's return to CERNOBIO conditions deteriorated in NS ITALY and PW was not able to despatch SAVORGNIANI to TRIEST.

43. At beg Mar 45 PW received from Abt III MILAN an agent called PARZANI, whom PW used to effect an introduction to Prof COEPO, 6 via dell'ACCADEMIA, MILAN. PW knew that COEPO had connections with the parties of GIOIIE and STEFANI, about whom he needed information. (STEFANI himself had been interned at LUZZANE since Oct 44). PW however was not able to make use of COEPO owing to the deteriorating situation.

44. At beg Apr 45 PW while at CERNOBIO was told by Grenzstelle WEST that a certain Dr MAURO had arrived from TRIEST, and had political information. PW ordered MAURO to be sent to his villa where he found that he had been a school friend of SAURO in TRIEST but was unable to discover what MAURO's intentions were. He told MAURO to visit him at his office in 2 via MENGONI, where MAURO called once or twice and on 15 or 16 Apr told PW that the "BRIGATA NERA" was preparing to overthrow the Fascist Republican Parties.

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11-7296

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P/O network ?

- 45. In mid-Apr PUCCI informed PW that the Republican Party had been preparing for the past six weeks to leave 600 men in NORTHERN ITALY. Those agents were to go to ground and cause trouble after the arrival of the Allies. They are all from the Brigata Nera and PW knows that the leader at GENOA is a "Dr".
- 46. On 24 Apr 45, WOLFF arrived at the villa LOCATELLI at CERNOBBIO and ordered PW to convey to MILAN a young priest who had been caught with two other British agents. On arrival at MILAN, PW found that the SD HQ was almost besieged and decided to stay at Hotel REGINA. The priest left for an unknown destination in PW's car.
- 47. On 24 Apr PW called on Cardinal SCINISTER and asked him to approach the CNL (Comitato Nazionale di Liberazione) with a view to avoiding bloodshed between the German forces (including the SD) and the Partisans.
- 48. At 0100 hrs of 25 Apr, WOLFF phoned from COMO to say that the MILAN authorities were to come to an agreement with the CNL and were to avoid bloodshed at all costs; they were however not to surrender to the Partisans. (PW later learned that WOLFF left COMO at 0300 hrs for SWITZERLAND).
- 49. A deputation from CNL visited the Hotel REGINA the same day and it was agreed that so long as the Hotel was not attacked, the SD would not engage in repressive activities.
- 50. PW surrendered with the remainder of the SD personnel on 28 Apr to Allied troops.

COMMENTS

It is recommended that PW be sent to CSBIC, ROME for detailed interrogation, particularly on :

- a) his activities in HOLLAND
- b) his full activities in ITALY
- c) his information on other agents.
- d) his activities in CERNOBBIO
- e) the CABIANCA School.
