MEMO TO: JAKE

SUBJECT: SHEBALYIN's Traffic Violation

The following details were obtained from Subject's wife on 12 Feb 1953:

Date of violation:	15 Oct 1952 Case #15528/52B
Place	Munich (exact square not known)
Charge:	Subject drove into center of square allegedly against direction of first traffic officer, to spot where second traffic officer was standing. He was directed to curb and written up.

Early in December 1952 the camp police contacted Subject's wife EEEK (first visit) and again visited her early in January and the last week of January. On the latter visit Mrs. Shebalyin was informed that the matter had been taken out of the hands of the local police and turned over to the traffic court listed below:

At first Subject explained to the police that her husband was in a sanitarium in Frankfurt. Later she told them that he ~~was to be transferred to another hospital in a few days~~ and she didn't know just where he would be until she had a letter from him. On the last visit the police informed her that the police in Munich had checked with every hospital ~~but had failed to locate him~~ therefore Mrs. Shebalyin was a liar and was hiding her husband from the police.

Mrs. Shebalyin believes that the police will again contact her either the end of February or early March at which time she fears they may arrest her. She has written her husband about the matter but he disregards his problem entirely. (We have also informed the Vienna office of this charge against Subject).
