SUBJECT: Contact with Grallspace 1, 13 May 1953

Opening of Meeting:

As arranged at previous meeting, agent Grallspace 1 and case officer [ ] met at 1000 hours on 13 May in front of the Mirabell Kino. Agent and case officer both appeared promptly. The weather being unusually fair, it was decided to hold the meeting in the Mirabell Park.

4. Agent and case officer spent the entire meeting "chewing the rag." They discussed world affairs, the USSR, ultimate victory over communism, women, free love in America and Europe, social habits, liberalism versus conservatism, etc. It was during one of these tangents that case officer remarked that Grallspace 1 must be very bored in Salzburg with nothing to do all day. Agent replied that it was boring but that he really didn't mind it too much. He said he studies his English quite a bit and spends a lot of time walking around town as well as reading. (Case officer's note: at almost every meeting agent tells case officer about a new book he has read.) In line with the conversation it was also remarked that "girls" are quite plentiful in Salzburg, too. Agent agreed but added, "Mädchen sind auch teuer."

5. Agent gave case officer some negatives of pictures which might be suitable for making the snapshots for his wife's PTD. (Case officer's note: the negatives were turned over to [ ] after the meeting for printing.)

Close of Meeting:

7. The meeting ended at 1100 hours. It was agreed to meet again at 1000 hours at the Mirabell Kino 20 May 19' 5.

Case Officer Comments:

8. Case officer feels relatively certain that agent's activities in Salzburg are secure and normal. He sends the greater share of his salary to his wife in Memmingen and leaves enough for himself on which to eat, buy books and cigarettes. The cost of girls and his lonesomeness for his family seem to have curtailed his night-life activity considerably.
