1. Operational considerations render it essential for the subject to be brought out of Austria and into the United States with a minimum of delay.

2. Since the subject's entry into this country under Section 203 of the Immigration and Nationality Act appears to be impracticable due to the time factor involved, it is desired to bring him in under the provisions of Section 8 of Public Law 110. However, since this method normally requires a delay of several weeks even after the individual concerned receives his Covert Security Clearance, it is requested that immediate action be undertaken to bring the subject, his wife, and his daughter into the country under "Special Procedures". The legalization of the subject's residence in the United States under Public Law 110 will be completed after his arrival.

3. The subject has already received the following clearances:

- Provisional Operational Clearance No. 898, 30 July 1951
- Provisional Operational Clearance No. 1685, 15 January 1952

4. The results of the subject's medical examination will be received by cable and forwarded to you at once.
