- A. Headquarters' Action Requested: None -- for information and files.
- B. Synopsis of Developments: Agent visited Memmingen, Germany (where his mother-in-law is living) during the Christmas holidays and there learned that all eighteen DP friends who applied for U. S. emigration at the same time as Grallspice 1 had received visas and emigrated to the States. This has caused a serious dip in agent's morale in that agent is beginning to despair of ever getting to the U. S.
- C. Developments:
 1. Grallspice 1, wife and daughter spent the Christmas holidays in Memmingen, Germany with agent's mother-in-law. Agent's daughter has been sick with the measles.
 2. While in Memmingen, agent learned that all 18 of his DP friends had received visas and emigrated to the States. These 18 persons had applied for emigration the same time as Grallspice 1. Seeing his friends emigrate on normal quota while he awaits priority action has caused a serious dip in agent's morale and has led to the fear that agent and family may decide to return to Germany in the hopes of finding greener fields. Agent's wife, a somewhat combustible type, has not been pleased with her existence in Salzburg nor has agent been pleased with his hopes of emigration. Hence agent may try to return to Memmingen. (See SSALZ-2107)
 3. Agent has been continuing his study of the U. S. Constitution.
