Meeting Arrangements

By previous arrangement AEBRIEF was met at his apartment 1466 Columbia Road, N.W. at 1600 26 February 1954.

Course

In view of developments during the meeting it was agreed that case officer would see agent at 1100 28 Feb 1954.

Conduct of Meeting

As soon as C.O. entered agent's apartment, agent complained of his tooth bothering him a great deal. He had mentioned this as a minor ailment at the previous meeting. C/O called DOB and then the Medical Office for a cleared dentist whom AEBRIEF could see. A cleared dentist was considered necessary as agent still does not have any documents. [redacted] of the Medical Office arranged matters and by 1710 C/O and agent were in the offices of [redacted] 1746 K St., N.W. Agent was identified by true name but no other info was given.

Agent and dentist were able to communicate in English, with the dentist, a former Army Major attempting to use some school and GI German. To the tune of a lot of joking and laughing [redacted] examined the patient, took xrays, ground one tooth and yanked a large ugly molar all in about 25 minutes. The charge was only five dollars. Agent remarked about how quick things happened in America but was pretty pleased with the whole performance. At the suggestion of the dentist agent was given a drink by case officer in a local pub and returned to his home at 1830.

C.O. added that it was just as well that he hadn't had a pain in his leg
