Met agent at 0900 at corner of Columbia Road & 15th Street, N.W. He was ten minutes late for which he apologized without explanation but he looked like he had overslept. He was taken in a company car to the offices of Dr. Dent 1801 K St. for x ray and fluroscopy. Appointment had been arranged by (C) in true name. After this had been completed agent and C.O. proceeded to (C) office where electro cardograph was made. C.O. will call (C) to learn results of examinations, and necessity if any of further appointments. Agent was dropped off at Harvard & 15th Street at 1115. Next meeting to be at 1545 in front of Masonic Temple on 16th Street 31 Mar 1954.

Agent described in brief his trip to N.Y. They went up and back by Greyhound Bus saw their various friends and relatives and seem to have enjoyed the trip. Agent spoke in some detail about how some of his friends were making such good money as \$400.00 a week in factories, both man and wife working. Other notations made by agent concerned his impressions of the trip and New York.

Agent's remarks about the high pay of his friends carried the connotation to C.O. that agent was surprised and pleased to realize that these friends and relatives of his who came to the U.S. only a few years ago could make their way with such little difficulty. This is a reaction we want to encourage.
