1. Mr. Schebalin was visited by a representative of our Wilmington Field Office on 15 January 1958, who found him to be extremely congenial with no problems or complaints. He is looking forward to attaining citizenship in about two years.

2. Schebalin has completed his fourth semester at La Salle College. Except for one "D" in Mathematics, which was the highest grade given in that class, he has maintained a "B+" average. He reportedly will graduate as an engineer in two years. Subject continues to reside at 4701 Wayne Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

3. At Brown Instrument Company, where he is employed, Schebalin has been promoted to the position of Assistant Engineer in the Competitive Tests Division. His present assignment will last for about two more years before he is reassigned to other duties. His present salary is \$100 per week. His degree of adjustment is excellent, this progress is reflected in both his work and social development. There is no indication of activities prejudicial to the United States.
