1. Mr. Schebalin was visited at his home by a representative of our Wilmington Field Office in January 1959. The family was found to be in their usual good health and high spirits. The Schebalin's are looking forward to 4 February 1959 when they will be able to petition for United States citizenship.

2. Sergei continues to work for Brown Instrument Company in Philadelphia, and his present weekly salary is \$107; Mrs. Schebalin is maintaining a \$35 - \$40 weekly income by working as a film mounter for Perfect Photo Company, Philadelphia.

3. Schebalin is also looking forward to receiving his engineering degree from La Salle College in the Spring of 1960.

4. All observable evidence indicates that the Schebalin family is making a successful and satisfactory adjustment to the American way of life.
