On or about 27 September 1954, SHIGEMITSU Mamoru called on OASA Tadao, leader and controller of "purse strings" of the Progressive Party, to ask his assistance in staying in the good graces of the party. SHIGEMITSU reportedly told OASA that he would do anything in return for OASA's assistance. Although SHIGEMITSU has been receiving considerable publicity from the newspapers, in actuality he is being completely ignored in the new political moves.
