PETRASCU the setting up of this information service:

ACCUSED: I did not come sent by the Americans in 1947 but ... HORIA SIMA...

...
PRESIDENT: Why did you go back to Salzburg?

ACCUSED: I resided there and was to report what I had done in Rumania. I had to inform HORIA SIMA through VASILE MAILAT. Vasile MAILAT worked with the American information service.

...
ACCUSED: When I first returned from Rumania to Austria, HORIA SIMA sent BOROBANU to discuss with me, to see what the situation was in Rumania and to recommend someone for the duty of setting up an information service. I informed BOROBANU and discussed with him, as the Iron Guard movement from abroad wished to establish contacts with the American authorities in any way....

Statement of Witness ANDREI, DOGBAL CORNELIU

PRESIDENT: Did you know HORIA SIMA

WITNESS: Yes

PRESIDENT: Have you had any contacts with him?

WITNESS : Yes

...
PRESIDENT: What did you do with information material which was collected?

WITNESS: It was sent abroad to HORIA SIMA through the AMERICAN espionage service, through special couriers.

PRESIDENT: Did you know that the accused EUGEN TEODORESCU had come to RUMANIA to organize this service with HORIA SIMA's approval?

WITNESS: Yes.

...the accused men decided men decided to send an emissary abroad, in the person of the accused MAIU...his mission was to persuade the traitor Horia SIMA to participate in the activities led by the imperialist circles and co-ordinated from outside by traitors abroad.

...The police agent was Eugen TEODORESCU, who came to the country by repeated frontier crossings, carrying and bringing correspondence. All his activities had the approval of Horia SIMA, the traitor abroad, and of the accused PETRASCU now in the dock.


