ILLIAN, who left Rumania with the Germans in 1944, is playing a "leading role" in Salzburg and is probably in contact with Horia SIMA, and that both men must have contacts in Rumania; further, that rumors (which source believes to be false) are circulating that SIMA is looked upon with favor by the Americans and is organizing a resistance movement in Germany. ... a meeting took place in Bucharest ... (after failure of London Conference): ... SIMA, who was carrying on a pro-American policy abroad and was in American hands, might for that reason become a real peril for the Legionnaires in Rumania.
