<p>...In January, 1941...Antonescu crushed an incipient Iron Guard rebellion. These Iron Guard rebels were critical of Antonescu for not following Hitler's lead more closely. The Germans, though they accepted the fact that the rebel movement had been crushed, gave refuge to many of the leading spirits of the Iron Guard. Most of these men are now in Germany, some are in Austria, others in Italy, and more recently some of them have reached Argentina.
