Intelligence Activit of the Legionary Movement (Group Horia SIRA).</p> <p>Vasile IASINSKI, a close associate of Horia SIRA, was in PARIS in June 1949 while en route from Germany to Spain. He conferred with representatives of the Rumanian emigrant IS and of the French IS on cooperation of the Legionary Movement. It was agreed that the Legionary Movement would cooperate in the field of counterespionage, with Dr. Mircea IONESCO as its liaison man.</p> <p>Horia SIRA's Group also maintains intelligence connections with the American Embassy in PARIS via Leon NEGROZZI, who was formerly a member of the American Legion, and is married to an American. The American Embassy apparently pays NEGROZZI well for his work.</p> <p>Horia SIRA's Group also maintains a connection with the IS of the French occupation troops in the French Zone of Austria via Nicolae MARINESCU in INSBROCK and Mircea FILITRU, who is in contact with the CIC in LINZ and the British Command in GRAZ.</p> <p>14 Shortcomings of the Rumanian IS in PARIS</p> <p>...</p> <p>g.
