SECORZENI had two paratroop companies which had been organized in Germany, towards the end of the last war... ...The Legionary government headed by Horia SIMA was jealous of the organization of the two companies and hurriedly organized paratroop units of its own at Kornneuburg, which were manned by Legionaries and Volkdeutsche. One of those units was parachuted in Rumania after the Armistice, whereas none of TOBA's units were parachuted... ... p 4. ...Leonte COJOCARU, a Legionary Instructor who was promoted to Assistant Legionary Commandant in Vienna, at the time when SIMA headed his government there, heads the AGRAS...It is claimed that his protection is not valid.... Mircea DIMITRIU seems to be the liaison man between the "sinists" in Italy and Horia SIMA.</p> <p>...</p> <p>5.</p> <p>6. Engineer Mircea DIMITRIU, a Legionary Commandant, is probably SIMA's liaison man for Austria. SIMA himself seems to be living in the vicinity of Salzburg.</p> <p>...</p> <p>8. Engineer BOROBARU, Im, a Legionary Commandant from Fagaras, the county in which SIMA was born and raised, is probably the Legionary Chief for the whole of Europe.</p> <p>...</p>
