<p>"1. Enclosure No. 1 is a letter on Rumanian personalities and politics (particularly Iron Guardist) in Argentina received by headquarters through [ ] from [ ] in Buenos Aires. Below are traces from headquarters on some of these personalities:</p> <p>A. Horia SIMA: Formerly Vice-President of the Council in the Antonescu Government. In 1941, after an unsuccessful Iron Guard coup d'etat, he fled to German protection; and in August, 1944 he was set up by the Germans as head of a puppet Rumanian Government-in-exile' in Vienna. He travels extensively and clandestinely in Europe and regards himself as the present leader of the Iron Guard. Recent reports allege that he has been trying to infiltrate his agents into the Western Hemisphere."...</p> <p>"Page 2..."</p> <p>A. Ilie GARNEATA: Is a co-leader with Constatin PAPAN<sup>A</sup>CE of the dissident Iron Guard group known as the 'MEXICANII', opposed to the more numerous SIMA faction, and comprised chiefly of violent and radical Macedonians. (This faction blames the leadership of Horia SIMA for the decline of the Iron Guard. As of May, 1948 the 'MEXICANII' membership was put at about seventy persons (possibly by a detractor), with most of these in Germany and Italy."...</p>
