<p>"2. Instead of taking advantage of the extremely favorable circumstances, they failed to go on to the concrete realizations we all expected. The great rift between the 'Mexicans' and the 'Brigadiers' was repeated here and split up the 'Brigadier' faction itself, which is, as you know, made up of SIMA's men, into four groups:</p> <p>One is close to Prince Nicholas (Enescu, Cotrus, and Colonel Mavriki). Another has remained faithful to the old party line 100 per cent; it is made up of Iassinscki and of a group of young students.</p> <p>There is the extremist faction of Uscatescu, Popovici, and Rautza, which has the least ideological elements of all. Essentially, all are vulgar opportunists, of course.</p> <p>Finally there is the faction of Georget Demetrescu, Traian Popescu, and their acolytes, who are closest to SIMA, though they are at odds with Iassinscki."...</p>
