A. Franz-Wilhelm <sup>FR</sup>KIESOW <sup>3rd Germany</sup>  
DPOB: 20 August 1917, Swinemünde, E. Germany

In addition to the regular BDC checks which are performed, CATIDE is especially interested in any information in the Volksgerichtshof (People's Court) which supports KIESOW's claim that he was arrested by the SD in 1945 in connection with the 20 July 1944 attempt on Hitler's life. CASTROP is fairly sure that this is a falsification as the SD, which was strictly an intelligence organization, was not allowed to make arrests. This function was carried out by the Gestapo.

Subject was employed by the organization prior to December 1951.
