BONN INTELLIGENCE MEASURES

EAST BERLIN ADN IN GERMAN TO EAST GERMANY 1347 5 AUG 63 L

(TEXT) BERLIN--IT IS LEARNED FROM PARIS THAT BONN STATE SECRETARY GLOBKE HAS INSTRUCTED THE HEAD OF THE FEDERAL INTELLIGENCE SERVICE NAZI GENERAL GEHLEN, WHO IS SUBORDINATE TO HIM, TO SET UP A SO-CALLED PERSONNEL SCREENING COMMITTEE. ITS TASK WILL BE TO PREVENT FURTHER MEMBERS OF THE SECRET SERVICE TO BE UNMASKED AS LEADING S.D. --SECURITY SERVICE--AND GESTAPO OFFICIALS.

IT WILL BE REMEMBERED THAT GLOBKE RECENTLY STATED PUBLICLY THAT LESS THAN ONE PERCENT OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BONN SECRET SERVICE HAD BEEN MEMBERS OF THE S.S. OR S.D. GEHLEN HAS NOW BEEN INSTRUCTED TO TRANSFER ESPECIALLY INCRIMINATED PERSONS TO SUCH POSITIONS AS ARE CAMOUFLAGED AS NOT BELONGING TO THE FEDERAL INTELLIGENCE SERVICE, SO AS TO AVOID FURTHER CHARGES AGAINST HIS SECRET SERVICE.

IT HAS BECOME KNOWN THAT AMONG THE LEADING GEHLEN OFFICIALS WHO ARE NOW TO GO UNDERGROUND THERE ARE DR. FRANZ ALFRED SIX, HEAD OF THE GEHLEN DEPARTMENT "H" AND FOR MANY YEARS EICHMANN'S SUPERIOR IN THE CHIEF REICH SECURITY OFFICE; DR. EMIL AUGSBURG, LEADING OFFICIAL OF THE CENTRAL OFFICE OF THE FEDERAL INTELLIGENCE SERVICE AND FORMER S.D.-STUPMBANNFUEHRER; AND FRANZ GOERING, HEAD OF THE GEHLEN OFFICE "10" IN HAMBURG AND FORMER SPECIAL DELEGATE OF THE HEAD OF DEPARTMENT 6 OF THE CHIEF REICH SECURITY OFFICE.
