ACCORDING ZIPPER SKORZENY CERTAINLY IN GERMANY PAST SUMMER, WHERE HE APPROACHED, AMONG OTHER GENERALS BONIN AND GUDERIAN. SKORZENY STATED THAT HE ARRANGING FOR REMOVAL OF UP TO 200,000 MEN TO SPAIN EVENT OF WAR. SKORZENY CLAIMED TO HAVE AMERICAN APPROVAL AND SUPPORT. HE ACCOMPANIED BY COUNTESS FINKENSTEIN. LATTER ALSO APPROACHED HEGEIA, SPANISH CONSUL IN FRANKFURT, WITH SIMILAR STORY. SKORZENY TOLD GUDERIAN IN SEPTEMBER HE LEAVING SHORTLY FOR SPAIN. ACCORDING ZIPPER, DPA REPORTED FROM MADRID ON 13 JANUARY SKORZENY SEEN THERE AND THAT FRIENDS OF HIS IN MADRID HAD STATED HE LIVING THERE UNDER FALSE NAME. ZIPPER HAS LOW OPINION OF SKORZENY AND HAS ADVISED ITS PEOPLE TO HAVE NOTHING TO DO WITH HIM. SEE MGLA 4631 OF 3 JAN 51.
