SPECIFIC— Former Fascist Personalities

1. The following information evaluated C-3 received through   is forwarded for the information of stations interested.

2. Jean Beauverd, liaison officer between Sir Oswald Mosley and the neo-fascistic organization MSI in Italy, formerly residing in Paris, has moved permanently to Madrid. Beauverd, who travels with a Swiss passport and is allegedly under penal sentence in Switzerland, facilitated the move with the aid of the notorious Otto Skorzeny who also managed to get him a job with Agathis International Features Service, Delegation en Europa, Madrid, Infantas 21. Beauverd is principally engaged in getting European publications to print articles written by Skorzeny.

3. The former German Foreign Office official, Dr. Rudolf Rahn, who was posted to Turkey in 1931 and Portugal in 1938, a specialist in Near East affairs who was also Germany's Foreign Office representative with their army in Tunisia in 1942, and Hitler's last Ambassador to Mussolini in 1943, is reported to have been traveling in Spain and Portugal since March 1951. Rahn is reportedly visiting former German Foreign Office personnel in Madrid and has also made contact with Spain's Minister Serano Suner and Otto Skorzeny in Madrid.
