1. Reference is made to your memorandums of 29 August 1955, and 1 November 1955, File No. 100-344753 regarding the above subject.

2. Information from our field representatives shows that the SEKIZNY's offer to furnish data regarding Rote Kapelle traffic was received through the office of the U.S. Air Attache at Madrid. SEKIZNY's offer actually consisted of a claim by him that he had information concerning German success in reading the encrypted communications of the Soviet Rote Kapelle net, but this Agency's field representatives received no concrete evidence to support the claim. In view of the fact that SEKIZNY is regarded by this Agency as unreliable, as evidenced by previous experiences with his offers, no action is planned by this Agency.
