On 16 June SKORZENY upon his return to Madrid after a trip to Germany and Ireland, telephoned [ ] to say that he had returned to Madrid and had also received information that his request for a visa had been denied and therefore had cancelled his plans to go to Canada for the television broadcast of his wartime exploits. Since the prime purpose of his trip was to have been of a business nature in the United States, he did not want to go just to Canada. The conversation was a friendly one in which he made a tentative social date for the following week.</p> <p>2. On 22 June Reference A was received recommending that [ ] not contact SKORZENY for any information on his travel. On 24 June SKORZENY saw [ ] in downtown Madrid and during the course of the conversation the following information was learned:</p> <p>A. SKORZENY and his wife have just closed a deal on the purchase of a farm outside of Dublin, Ireland where they will spend their summers and they plan eventually to retire there.</p> <p>B. SKORZENY has received a proposal from the Coutinho Caro &amp; Co., a German steel firm of Dusseldorf and Hamburg, to make a four week economic survey of Mexico and Central America for the possible expansion and sales of this firm's industrial steel products in that area. This tentative offer is still in the planning stage which SKORZENY says he will not accept unless the company will also pay the expenses of his wife's travel with him. He stated he has no intention of moving his Headquarters from Madrid in the foreseeable future. The Central American plan is only a one-time trip for which he is being considered because of his Spanish and English language ability and it is extremely indefinite.</p> <p>C. The only possible future residences he plans are his farm in Ireland, Madrid, and possibly a house on the French Riviera where his wife is engaged in real estate development.</p> <p>3. [ ] Station may pass to Mexican officials any information in Reference C which in their discretion is applicable and does not embarrass KUBARK, when and if SKORZENY's trip becomes definite.</p> <p>4. Headquarters is requested to forward a copy of Reference C to Mexico City.</p>
