VIENNA 5068, 18 April 1968</p> <p>In commenting a few days ago on the conviction and sentencing of Slavik, which was reported in the local press, []] noted that his service still had no liaison with []] and would try to get a copy of the trial record through the Austrian Embassy. He also maintains Slavik was an KIS agent rather than an Austrian one, and feels that the Turks may realize this, but, for political reasons, may have preferred to put Slavik out of circulation as an Austrian spy. The []] are not concerned about Slavik being sentenced, but would like assurance that, at least in the eyes of the Turkish authorities, if not the public, he is recognized for what they think he is, namely a Soviet agent. []] asked if WOVIEH []] could clarify this. We would appreciate any relevant comment you can make.</p>
