<p>1. [] [] reported unilaterally during 2 March and 24 March operational meetings that Dr. Adolf SLAVIK ([] []), who visited Istanbul in October 1965, was unilaterally surveilled by [] [] . The surveillance established that Subject contacted Oguz KUCUKKUTLU a retired Army officer and then a candidate of the Istanbul C. K. M. P. <p>2. Suspected to be a RIS agent with international connections, SLAVIK resides in Vienna, Austria, Simmeringen Hauptstrasse 78/2/7, Wien 11. He has been expelled from France and the [] [] Liaison to Istanbul [] [] is still interested in his moves and contacts.</p>		
<p>3. SLAVIK is a business associate and probably a co-owner of the "Marmara Ticaret" import-export firm, founded by Beno STEINER in Istanbul, Bahcekapi, Umum Sigorta Han 612/614. STEINER, a Hungarian Jew from Czechoslovakia purchased Austrian citizenship in 1952 and died in Vienna in the early 1960's.</p>

The business activities of his Istanbul firm were mysterious and [] Soviet Desk knew that STEINER used to receive Soviet visitors at 0200 hours in the night.

4. The firm is presently headed by Viktor ROZANES, Turkish national of Jewish origin; employs fnu YUSUFIAN, Turkish national of Armenian extraction; another Armenian secretary and two Turkish janitors. Although the business volume of the firm is marginal, the personnel is known to travel abroad and to frequently visit Turkish [] with adjacent military installations. The Soviet Desk of [] is currently investigating the activities of the firm and made a preliminary study for an eventual technical operation which would reveal connections to Adolf SLAVIK.

5. [] reports the above firm (tel. no.: 222066) in business contact with the Czech, East German and Rumanian Trade Missions in Istanbul. The firm is selling Czech-made gas meters, Rumanian synthetic fibers and paints and in December 1965 negotiated purchase of 8 knitting machines from the "KOVO" national enterprise, Prague. Viktor ROZANES visited Bucarest, Rumania in November 1965 and fnu YUSUFIAN discussed in December 1965 in East Berlin purchase of coal briquets machinery from the "Diamaschinen". ROZANES is in contact with Gustav MERGL, "Kovo" representative in Istanbul and a suspected member of the Czech I.S. []
