1. CASE FIRST CAME TO BASE ATTENTION 29 AUG 67 WHEN PRESS REPORTED MINISTER OF COMMERCE OFFICIAL TURGUT POJON HAD BEEN ARRESTED FOR SELLING INFO TO AN AUSTRIAN BUSINESSMAN SILAVIK (SLAVIK). ACCORDING TO THIS REPORT, IN FEB 67, SECURITY OFFICIALS ARRESTED POJON AND SLAVIK IN ANKARA HOTEL AND RECOVERED DOCUMENTS INCRIMINATING A JUSTICE PARTY SENATOR AND A DEPUTY FROM THE REPUBLICAN PEOPLES PARTY (RPP) (UNIDENTIFIED). 30 AUG PRESS IDENTIFIED POJON AS A DIEHARD LEFTIST WHO HAD WORKED IN TURKISH EMBASSY IN VIENNA AND HAD MET SLAVIK WHILE THERE (DATE NOT GIVEN). 1 SEPT PRESS IDENTIFIED TWO POLITICIANS INVOLVED AS SENATOR ALAETTIN CEVIK AND DEPUTY CELAL SUNGUR.

2. TO OUR KNOWLEDGE, CASE DROPPED FROM PRESS UNTIL MILITARY TRIAL OF SLAVIK OPENED 6 FEB 68. PRESS REPORTED THAT CETIN AND SUNGUR BEING ACCUSED OF SELLING INFO TO "GERMAN SPY ADOLF STAVING" WHO IDENTIFIED AS 45 YEAR OLD FORMER GERMAN SS OFFICER WHO "SPIED" IN CASABLANCA FROM 1957-1960 AND WHO CAUGHT REDHANDED IN TURKEY

IN 1964 ^{RECEIVED} ^{MAR 29 2 30 PM '68} ^{FORWARDED} ^{RID/EDI} TRYING TURKISH MILITARY INFO. ACCORDING TO REPORTS, TEN YEARS BEING DEMANDED FOR SLAVIK AND LIFE FOR POJON.

3. CASE APPARENTLY BROKEN BY ENOK OGUZ KUCUKKURT, FORMER TURKISH AIR FORCE OFFICER. ACCORDING TO STORY BEING PLAYED AT PRESENT TRIAL, KUCUKKURT IN 1961 READ AD IN LOCAL PRESS STATING FOREIGNER SEEKING TURKISH TEACHER. KUCUKKURT ANSWERED AD AND MET SLAVIK. FRIENDSHIP ESTABLISHED AND AFTER ABOUT SIX MONTHS OF REGULAR CONTACT, KUCUKKURT BECAME SUSPICIOUS OF SENSITIVE QUESTIONS BEING ASKED BY SLAVIK. HE CONTACTED INTELLIGENCE OFFICIALS AND UNDER LATTER DIRECTION, BEGAN BOTH REPORTING ON SLAVIK AND PASSING TO SLAVIK NON-SENSITIVE INFO PROVIDED BY SECURITY SERVICE. ON FINAL CONTACT WITH SLAVIK (PRESUME FEB 1967), KUCUKKURT DELIVERED INTEL REPORT PROVIDED BY SERVICE TO SLAVIK IN ISTANBUL HOTEL ROOM, TAPED MEETING WITH CONCEALED RECORDER TAPED ON HIS PERSON, AND LEFT ROOM. SERVICE AGENTS IMMEDIATELY ARRESTED SLAVIK.

4. TRIAL STILL IN PROGRESS. IMMUNITY OF DEPUTY AND SENATOR REPORTEDLY STILL IN EFFECT.

5. I HAD ADVISED THAT I HAD BEEN MONITORING SLAVIK CASE FOR SOME TIME. SEE
