At a dinner party on 4 December at the home of German Consul Dr. Leonhard KREMER, [ ] met Haluk Rize KUNUTKU, an Istanbul lawyer, who is currently defending Adolf SLAVIK against charges of espionage. KUNUTKU confirmed the information received [ ] from [ ], and said that SLAVIK has maintained throughout the trial that he was working only for himself, collecting economic information with the intention of passing it eventually to Austrian and Swiss banks. KUNUTKU said that SLAVIK will not go beyond this explanation even with his Turkish defense consul, whom he does not trust; he recently brought a lawyer from Austria who was allowed to cooperate on his defense.</p> <p>2. KUNUTKU is convinced that the two Turkish deputies accused of providing SLAVIK with political and economic information supplied valuable information and knew fully well that they were collaborating. According to KUNUTKU, for political reasons, both were exonerated and will probably escape punishment. As for SLAVIK, KUNUTKU believes that the prosecutor will request 15 years; however, the case is now built around the documents supplied by the [ ] agent and thus not very convincing.</p> <p>3. KUNUTKU is evidently in contact with [ ] personnel and stated that one of the [ ] officers admitted to him that his service made several mistakes in the SLAVIK case.</p> <p>4.
