Shea of Eastern Economics Relations Branch, NICOG, with copies of the BFV report in order that he may be in a position to provide them with necessary supplemental information. Mr. Shea has informed me that he has recently discussed various aspects of the economic and political activity of the HOFFMANN-SCHMITT-NOACK complex with Col Marshal and Maj Briggs of ID, USAREUR, and that these officers expressed the desire that your Hqs be kept informed through my office of developments in this investigation. I will, therefore, be able to provide your Hqs with copies of any reports which Mr. Shea may wish to have transmitted to the BFV.

In the meanwhile, I will appreciate being informed at the earliest possible date of your comments re handling of the CIS intercept, which is identified and discussed in my previous memorandum on this subject, and as to whether or not you desire to contribute any information or guidance on the further handling of this case.
