- 1. Headquarters Action Required: None
- 2. Synopsis of Developments:

The agent was met twice during the period. No changes in the operational picture have occurred.

3. Account of Developments:

- a. The agent was met twice. He delivered a translation of the letter which is the subject of [ ] 647.
- b. At our last contact with NOSTRIL on 22 December 1954 he reported that [ ] appeared to be out of danger and well on the road to recovery. We instructed him not to leave [ ] in the private room in the hospital any longer than was necessary as this would be inconsistent with his poverty-stricken status. We feel that placing [ ] in a private room was well worth the additional expense, not only from the security point of view but also because the agent's confidence and loyalty have been reinforced by so doing.
