Subject was terminated by the  Station in 1955 since he was emigrating to the United States.

He arrived in the U.S. in 1955 and took up residence in the Circanian emigre colony in Paterson, N.J. Subject lives at 47 North Third Street in Paterson. He takes a great interest in the affairs of his emigre group which is a closely-knit one.

Subject obtained a job with a Plymouth agency in Paterson as a night watchman, but because of his initiative was soon promoted to salesman. He worked at the job until March of 1956 when, after having passed the competitive insurance agent exam of the State of New York, he was hired as an insurance salesman by The New York Mutual Life Insurance Company. He is employed there at this time.

Subject was interviewed and assessed completely by SR Division. The results of his assessment are considered most favorable and a clearance is requested for his operational use.
