Pursuant to your letter of 25 September, 1979, I herewith furnish you with the following information concerning my Freedom of Information request dated 21 September 1979 and received by your office on 24 September 1979.

Mr. Soobzokov has variously claimed birth dates of 24 August 1924 and 1 January 1918, at Taqhatamukai, Krasnodor Region, Union of Soviet Socialist Republic. His social security number is 137-30-9646. For your further information, Mr. Soobzokov was allegedly employed or had contact with the United States Army Material Test Unit Number 1, Fort George Meade, Maryland during a period of time encompassed at least by December of 1955 through January, 1958. While so employed or having contact with your department, Mr. Soobzokov was given an alias by your department, to wit: Sergei Zaravich.

For your further information, Mr. Soobzokov was allegedly employed by your department under special provisions by which the Material Test Unit Number 1 (8723) was authorized to conduct research programs. During his period of contact Mr. Soobzokov had correspondence and contact with, among others, the following personnel:
