I am in receipt of your letter of 9 October 1979. It is inconceivable to me that your office has been unable to find any records of the activities of Tscherim Soobzokov.

Because you stated in your letter that you have no records to indicate that any activity of the Army Material Testing Unit No. 1 was ever assigned to Fort Meade, I am enclosing herewith copies of documents received at the deposition of Tscherim Soobzokov clearly indicating the Unit to which I refer and the fact of its existence at Fort George Meade.

With this further information, I trust I will receive a full and complete reply concerning my earlier request with no further delay so that this matter may be resolved without resort to the Courts.
