<p>1. On 29 June 1979, <i>[]</i>, IMS/FPL/Litigation Section, and yourself met with Mr. Joseph F. Lynch, Department of Justice, Criminal Division, who reviewed the three volumes of sanitized material on Tscherim Soobzokov, at Headquarters.</p> <p>2. Upon Mr. Lynch's request to review Soobzokov's Soviet internal passport, which was not included in the sanitized files, a search was undertaken to locate it. A check of Soobzokov's 201 file and a check with the Office of Technical Services, Questioned Documents Lab, where the passport was suspected to have been used as an exemplar, failed to locate the document.</p>
