With regard to an action filed in the U.S. District Court in New Jersey to revoke the citizenship of Tscherim Soobzokov we would like to know if the following documents can be made available for our use:

1. The document dated December 30, 1942 which refers to Soobzokov as Chief of the Field Police and authorizes him to search all villages in the area. (This document is in German and has an English translation.)

5. Soobzokov's biography dated October 1959.
6. The polygraph report of December 14, 1959.
