Dear Mr. Ryan:

In response to your request of 1 April 1980, I have asked the appropriate offices of CIA to search their indices for any record of employment or association with one Robert Turner Wallace for the period 1950 to 1955. That search has surfaced nothing to counter our understanding that Mr. Wallace was an employee of the Department of State during that period and not associated with CIA. Our files contain no record that Mr. Wallace was an employee of CIA during that period, under State cover or otherwise; no record of approval for contact during that period; and no record of operational use of Mr. Wallace during that period.
