Dear Mr. Machak:

With regard to your letter of May 13, 1980, which was in response to our letter of March 31, 1980, concerning a search for an Operational Memorandum from Amman, Jordan, dated August 5, 1953, we understand that the Department of State recently received a copy of this Operational Memo from the Central Intelligence Agency plus a copy of a transmittal memorandum that accompanied the Operational Memorandum from the State Department to the Central Intelligence Agency in 1953.

Please verify if the Department of State sent this Operational Memorandum to the CIA in 1953 and the reason therefor. Also advise if the CIA replied to the Department of State in 1953 and if the Department of State sent any advice to the American Consul in Amman, Jordan, as a result thereof.

We would appreciate a copy of the Operational Memorandum and the transmittal letter as well as any communication to the Consul in Amman.

Also in your letter of May 13, 1980, you provided information about the V-30 Personal Data form which was the subject of our letter of March 26, 1980. We understand that the CIA also recently forwarded to the Department of State a copy of a V-30 dated August 19, 1952. Please advise if the V-30 form was used in the visa process of Mr. Soobzokov and if the CIA indicated how and from whom and when they obtained a copy of it.


