1. Reference is made to your memorandum dated 21 June 1955 requesting a covert security approval to permit Subject's use as an Agent under Project ABELOSSON and to our memorandum dated 26 October 1955 requesting results of overseas traces and investigation. Reference is also made to SA/2 memorandum dated 19 October 1955 and received in this office on 31 October 1955 which advises that traces at the [ ] reflect only a visa file containing limited biographical information, and that no other field traces were made.

2. Recent investigation conducted by this office reflects that Subject entered the United States in May 1955 for residency. Prior to this he lived in France, Germany, Latvia and Russia. It is also to be noted that the Subject has worked for French Intelligence.

3. Because of Subject's short period of residency in the United States, very little information was developed. Consequently, an approval is being granted contingent upon favorable results of additional overseas traces and investigation.

4. It is the recommendation of this office that Subject be afforded a technical interview once the results of overseas traces and investigation are received.
