1. AUNER NEVER HANDLED BY RYLAND. WAS MUNI AGENT.
2. SPITZ RECRUITED BY CAPTAINS MICHAELIS AND TIMM. SPITZ AND HIS FRIEND FLOSH ASSISTED MUNI IN RECOVERING SOME THREE OR FOUR MILLION DOLLARS WORTH OF RSHA CONFIDENTIAL FUNDS IN GOLD DOLLARS AND POUNDS.
3. UPON REDEPLOYMENT SPITZ'S CASE OFFICERS RYLAND INSTRUCTED IMPLEMENT PROMISE ASSIST SPITZ IN REHABILITATION IN RETURN FOR HIS SERVICES. DETAILS KNOWN TO STUBBS.
