3. Overt text will end with the same word the covert text begins with.
4. Instead of a period at the end of first sentence of covert text use an X.
5. Always use a word beginning with the letter "V" as the first word of the fourth sentence of your overt text.

All letters containing S/W to AECOB/3 will have a printed G and R i a will be written.

Recognition signals: To establish contact with AECOB/3, contact man will say to Oskars, "You look a lot like a man I know named Joe Miller. Could he possibly be your relative?" Oskars will answer: "No, I know a Hugo Miller, but I'm not his relative either."

AECOB/3 has S/W ink #1 from CAIUSO/2. (CAIUSO/2's System "Zebra").
