STANKIEVITCH, Stanislaw

2 March 1953

R.I. File [] dated 2 June 1951 states that files of CIC Central Registry revealed that Stanislaw STANKIEVIC was former leader of White Ruthenian DP Camp at Osterhofen and a member of the Praesidium of White Ruthenian National Committee, an illegal organization which operated in Western Zones of Germany. From 1941 to 1945, Stankiewicz occupied many positions of trust in Nazi administration, one of which was editor of the newspaper RANICA, a pro-Nazi, anti-Allied, White Ruthenian language publication.

R.I. Registry file #200-7-4-26, an intelligence dispatch # MCN-4-3736 dated 17 August 1950. Subject attended ABN convention in Edinburgh, Scotland in June 1950 - spelling is S. STANKIEWITSCH ABN is Anti-Bolshevik Block of Nations.

R.I. Registry File 32-7-10-90 - Document entitled Survey of Russian Emigration p. 87 regarding Byelorussian National Center - states Subject is one of leading members of BNC. It maintained regular contacts with Byelorussian organizations throughout the world. This document was prepared in U.S. Zone of Germany in last 3 months of 1950.
