*STAHLMANN, Hans [] Born: unknown; CAVATA member; CIT: ?

(Paragraph 2) - CAVATA's Bulgarian Operation: CABOLT reviewed the entire operation against DAMYANOV and the members of the Bulgarian Trade Mission, but added little that was not already known. In covering this matter, he commented on two of the CAVATA personnel who were involved. According to CABOLT, CAVAT's PIETSCH, who was in contact with CAVIRIL throughout the operation, did not seem to know what he was doing most of the time. He called several times to Munich to ask that certain action be taken, only to call back within hours and retract his request. On the other hand, CAVATA's STAHLMANN, who made a fruitless trip to Munich in a vain attempt to interview DAMYANOV, was friendly, polite and seemed to realize clearly what was going on and just how much could be done.
