Translation of messages exchanged between Tiebar Station and the Latvian Station Valdemar

Reference: WSSA-2072 of 8 November 1950

1. The following messages were exchanged between the Valdemar Station and the Tiebar Station and were obtained from Tilbury via []

2. Text of the messages, including date of transmission, is as follows:

Carla

- a) From Valdemar, 6 November 1950: "THE BEST TIME FOR US IS FROM NINE HUNDRED TO SEVENTEEN HUNDRED HOURS WHEN PEOPLE ARE BUSY WORKING. THIS IS FOR EXTRA COMMUNICATION TIME."
- b) To Valdemar, 10 November 1950: "IN THE END OF OCTOBER THE FISHERMEN EDUARDS KLAVLABA IN VENTSPILS BROUGHT A RELIABLE MAN HERE. AGREED WITH KLAVLABA ABOUT OTHER TRIPS. SEE IF THE TRIP HAD ANY CONSEQUENCES FOR HIM."
- c) From Valdemar, 13 November 1950: "I NOW CAN BEGIN WITH THE NEW CODE."
- d) From Valdemar, 20 November 1950: "THERE IS A FISHERMAN NAMED KLAVLABA IN VENTSPILS. THE LAST PART OF YOUR MESSAGE COULD NOT BE READ."
