Caller: Hungarian Red Cross?  
 Callee: No, Hungarian Embassy speaking.  
 Caller: Here is Dr. REMENY, director of the Pester Hungarian  
 Commercial Bank. I want to ask you to give the fol-  
 lowing message to Baron Ervin ROSZNER, Vienna, Bruck-  
 nergasse 4/4a, with Paul BAYERLEIN; Baron ROSZNER  
 shall visit doctor Eugen MARGARETA and shall accept  
 there a document which Dr. MARGARETA will hand over be-  
 cause of a telegram which the managers LAZAR, TAKACSI,  
 and DOMONYI addressed to Dr. MARGARETA.  
 The management of the bank asks Baron ROSZNER not to  
 go to Budapest as long as he is not in possession of  
 this document. If he has difficulties he shall inform  
 us by cable and shall ask for our disposition.
