1. We have instructed Grossbahr that contact with CC-3 will not be broken, even though he may depart for the U. S., until a decision is reached as to how we can best utilize her in the future.
2. As the record will indicate, Grossbahr has an extremely high opinion of CC-3. She has proven an efficient, devoted, and untiring worker with strong pro-U. S. motivation.
3. According to Grossbahr, she can, without too much difficulty, obtain employment with either the:
 - a. Verfassungsschutz in a secretarial capacity; or
 - b. The German Foreign Office, with probable assignment in Japan due to her fluency in the Japanese language. (During the war she was a Japanese censor. Though out of practice, she should have no difficulty regaining her former level of fluency.)
4. Off hand, our choice would be the Verfassungsschutz; however we feel we are not conversant enough with current developments in Germany to accurately judge the value of a source placed in that office. Request that Headquarters advise by cable which choice is preferred in order that we may initiate preliminary action with CC-3.
5. Munts, who already knows her, will maintain contact should this be necessary due to Grossbahr's departure. We will continue her salary (2,500 AS monthly) until contact no longer rests with us.
