SUBJECT: Inge von der TANN

1. In a recent file review, we ran across old records on Inge von der TANN-RATHSAMHAUSEN, who was GROSSBAHN's secretary and office manager in Salzburg. We are interested (somewhat belatedly) in determining what happened to her when she returned to Germany, because of a signed statement in our files which she wrote in November 1953. The statement, which you forwarded to Headquarters, confirms her "unswerving faith in FBPRIME and her willingness to work for ODYOKE at any time."

2. As far as Headquarters records show, you were in contact with Inge von der TANN shortly before her departure for Germany in March 1954 after her association with the GROSSBAHN operation ended. The German Station was given a forwarding address in Munich where Subject could be reached, but it is not recorded that contact was made. Time may have altered the sentiments expressed in her letter, or she may not occupy a position we could profitably exploit, but we consider that further investigation is called for before the file is closed. Any information you can contribute concerning her activities subsequent to her arrival in Munich o/a 1 April 1954 would be very much appreciated.
