A. LETTER.

B. HISTORY.

Formation : The date of the formation of FAT 205, formerly Trupp 205, is not known but it was actively in existence on the North Russian front as early as 1943. Its Feldpostnummer is believed to have been 00961.

Activities : FAT 205 remained on the North Russian front during 1944, retreating eventually to Danzig which it reached in April 1945. During this time it was subordinate to FAT 204 and carried out "R"-Aufgaben (stay-behind sabotage work), "S"-Aufgaben (parachute sabotage missions), and "Z"-Aufgaben (spreading subversive propaganda) in Russia and Poland. In January or February 1945 it was attached to the German Second Army.

Withdrawal to Germany : In April 1945 THOMSEN flew to Berlin from Danzig but the remainder of the unit went by boat to Copenhagen and then back to Berlin to rejoin THOMSEN via Prenzlau. In Berlin the unit was reformed and false identity documents and tins of sabotage material were issued. They then went on instructions to Hamburg and set up their Headquarters at Neritz. It was decided to let the Allied advance roll over them in Hamburg and Lt. KELLER supervised the burial of the sabotage equipment in the Hamburg neighbourhood. On 2nd May, 1945, the FAT moved into Hamburg itself and next day retreated to Itzehoe. On 5th May, 1945, THOMSEN dissolved the FAT and told the members to go to their homes.

G. APPRECIATION OF SUCCESS OR FAILURE.

Lt. LAUE has stated that FAT 205 did not have great success in any of its work against the Russians and that much sabotage equipment had to be abandoned in the retreat to the West.
