1. After discussing the Subject with [] it is requested that you make your combined recommendations concerning the further handling of this case.
2. You will recall that in the course of our briefing conferences, it was agreed that Subject's material was very high grade and included some of our top priority targets. However, we have since seen other indications along the lines suggested by the reference, i.e. that Subject is working simultaneously for the Swedes and probably - either directly or indirectly - for some other Services.
3. We further refer you to a recent cable from our Technical Section indicating that the identical material obtained from Subject on "Ramona" was apparently distributed by the British.
4. The foregoing consequently contains both pros and cons with regard to the wisest future course. Perhaps the best place for a decision on further handling is at your end and the best time, after you have had him looked over and re-evaluated. He may well be the type of source that can remain highly useful without serving us exclusively.
5. In examining the facilities that may be opened to Subject and his associates, please pay particular attention to those leading to our priority targets and advise.
