REFERENCES: a) LSS-191 dated 24 March 1947.

In connection with reference (b) Subject was on 8 April 1947, again requested to contact LILLIANBERG.

At their second meeting on 8 April the attitude of LILLIANBERG was much different than on the previous occasion. At this point it was no doubt apparent to him that Subject would not be forced into cooperation with the Swedes and therefore, his new attitude, which was one of appeasement and mutual assistance, in return for any information Subject could give them.

LILLIANBERG stated they had again reconsidered his situation and project and were agreed to help him proceed to Poland. It would, however, be necessary he proceed alone and he would be passed thru Denmark and taken to Lubeck by the Danes and from there proceed to his destination in Poland. LILLIANBERG stated this route would be less hazardous, especially since they were now cooperating 100% with the Danes in matters of this type. Subject has agreed to this arrangement and it is believed he will depart from Sweden o/a 21 April and will return after a 3-4 week period.

At this point there appears to be a definite understanding between this office and Subject with regard to the dissemination of the material, he will in the future receive from Lithuania. Subject has agreed to make no distribution of any material without our prior knowledge and approval.

Subject has also received word he will any day receive the pouch material from the SCLR which has been awaited since early February 1947. This material will be forwarded as quickly as possible in order that a more complete evaluation may be made of the material as well as the potential value of this Source and line.
